



## How is Grady EMC Governed?

Grady EMC's by-laws specify that we are governed by a board of seven directors. Our board consists of Grady EMC members who have been elected by fellow members to provide oversight to the actions of Grady EMC. This model of leadership and local control has allowed Grady EMC to grow with our South Georgia region for the last 75 years while staying true to our roots as a member owned co-op.

Grady EMC's service area is divided into seven districts and each district is represented by a director living in that district. Directors are elected to a three year term with the districts rotating for election at Grady EMC's Annual Meeting. Elections are held by a secret ballot vote of members present at the Annual Meeting and the candidate with the most votes wins the election. This year, districts one, four, and seven are up for election.

*The Georgia Public Service Commission publishes a bi-annual report that compiles the rates of Electric Membership Corporations, municipal providers and the investor owned utility companies operating in the state of Georgia. The report is published in the winter (using January rates) and summer (using July rates.)*

*This list is available through the Georgia Public Service Commission and shows the amount customers in each service area would pay for using 2,000 kilowatt hours and breaks the charge down to how much the provider charges per kilowatt hour.*

*In the 2015 Summer Survey listed above, Grady EMC was 25th in the state at \$0.1160 cents per kilowatt hour. We have highlighted the providers that provide power in our service area.*
